Intentions

This Agreement between the Railroad Museum of Long Island (hereafter "RMLI") and Strasburg Rail Road Company (hereafter "SRC") extends the terms of the original Agreement To Restore and Operate LIRR G5s Steam Locomotive 39 for an additional 36 months beyond the expiration of the original Agreement entered into by the parties on March 15th, 2013.

Length of This Extension

The extension will be effective from March 16^{th} of 2027 and terminate on March 15^{th} of 2030.

Terms

The terms of the original agreement remain in effect and unchanged. Schedule A Extended establishes the amount to be paid by RMLI to SRC by calendar year for the duration of this extension.
